Background:	The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) personnel have been working closely with the Rio Grande Valley MPO and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to establish the dates for the upcoming Transportation Management Area (TMA) certification review required under title 23 United States Code (USC) 134(k) and 49 USC 1607. The review of the RGVMPO metropolitan transportation planning process will take place on December 5-6th, 2024 at the Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (Ken Jones Boardroom, Building B at 301 W. Railroad, Weslaco, TX 78596). The last federal TMA Certification Review was completed in December 8-10, 2020, and in May 2021 FHWA offices transmitted a letter certifying that the RGVMPO was substantially compliant with USC 134(k) and 49 USC 1607.
