SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF TITLE VI REQUIREMENTS FOR Rio Grande Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization

WHEREAS, The Rio Grande Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization (RGVMPO), hereby agrees as a condition to receiving any Federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation, that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Acts of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d-42 U.S.C. 2000d-4, and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation-Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and other pertinent directives, to the end that in accordance with the Act, Regulations, and other pertinent directives, no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the RGVMPO receives Federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the RGVMPO has developed a Limited English Proficiency Plan, that with the following required documents have been reviewed, signed, and made available for viewing by the public, in both English and Spanish languages:

- 1. Complaint Procedures
- 2. Discrimination Complaint Consent
- 3. Discrimination Complaint Form
- 4. Nondiscrimination Statement
- 5. Title VI Assurances
- 6. Title VI DBE Assurances

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rio Grande Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Policy Board agreed by a majority vote to approve the Limited English Proficiency Plan and required documents for Title VI compliance.
