

RESOLUTION 2022-02

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE FY 2021-2024 HIGHWAY & TRANSIT TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AND 2045 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP)


