WHEREAS, the Brownsville Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMPO) received an apportionment of federal TASA funds for FY2019-2020 and awarded \$318,965 of these funds to Cameron County for construction of the Olmito Sidewalks (CSJ 0921-06-326) project; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 the BMPO merged with the Hidalgo County Metropolitan Planning Organization (HCMPO) and Harlingen-San Benito Metropolitan Planning Organization (HSBMPO) to form the Rio Grande Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization (RGVMPO); and

WHEREAS, the RGVMPO is the current designated agency for Transportation Planning in the Transportation Management Area and the responsible agency for approving changes and selecting projects that receive TASA funding; and

WHEREAS, Cameron County, in coordination with the RGVMPO and TxDOT Pharr District, requests an Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) amendment to reflect changes to the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the RGVMPO Transportation Policy Board agreed by majority vote to approve the Amendments Olmito Sidewalks (CSJ 0921-06-326) project.
